Events and activities that will not be permitted in Point Pleasant Park:

- 1/ Any event that involves off-trail use of the park. As PPP is in a vital reforestation stage, users are not permitted to go into these areas.
- 2/ Bicycle races.
- 3/ Items such as tents, inflatable games, and obstacle courses are not permitted inside the park.
- 4/ Live or recorded music is not allowed.
- 5/ Only events that are not-for-profit and do not charge fees to participate will be considered.
- 6/ Any event which in whole or part violates any portion of a Municipal by-law.

Events that are permitted:

Weddings

Weddings will be permitted at 7 locations:

- 1/ Quarry Pond.
- 2/ Cedar walk summerhouse.
- 3/ Point Pleasant summerhouse.
- 4/ Field adjacent to Point Pleasant Battery.
- 5/ Fort Ogilvie.
- 6/ Prince of Wales tower.
- 7/ Purcell's landing.

Receptions are not permitted.

ONE vehicle pass may be approved to transport elderly attendees or material to the site, but vehicles are not permitted to remain on site.

Prior to the ceremony an announcement should be made that throwing of confetti or similar material is strictly prohibited.

Picnics and BBQ's

Due to the possible fire hazard, BBQ's will ONLY be allowed at locations between Sailor's Memorial Way and the shoreline. No open fire/charcoal style BBQ's will be permitted.

All sites shown on the map have a picnic table, however the following sites can accommodate larger groups of 50-100 people:

- 1/ Black Rock Beach picnic area.
- 2/ Point Pleasant Summerhouse.
- 3/Sailor's Memorial Way areas 1-7.
- 4/ Tidal lawn.

Runs/Walks

A detailed route map must be provided with event application.

Participants must not run/walk more than 2 abreast.

No flagging or painting is allowed. It will be up to the event organizer to provide extra people if directional assistance is required.

Plays

Must coordinate with Shakespeare by the Sea (SBS) to ensure no overlap in performance or rehearsal times. SBS will make available in the spring a seasonal calendar of performances and rehearsals for the Cambridge battery site.

Filming

Filming within HRM is handled through the filming office and the procedure can be found at <http://www.halifax.ca/film/index.html>

The following will govern any filming that may subsequently occur:

- All cameras must be stand alone or carried. No tracks will be allowed.
- Only the filming portion may occur within the park. No trailers, tents, or additional supplies of any kind are allowed in the park.

Park Rules and Regulations

- All municipal by-laws must be adhered to.

- Please remember that parks belong to everyone and all are welcome to enjoy them. Areas cannot be roped off or otherwise isolated from general public access.
- When the event is complete, the site must be returned to its original state, with all debris removed.
- Costs to repair any damages arising from the event will be charged back to the event holder.
- The HRM has the right to refuse any event from being booked.
- HRM does not provide access to electricity.

Parks staff responsibilities

Parks Operations staff will check the site and do necessary clean up or repairs prior to the event.

Vehicle passes will be made available at the Park maintenance office, 5718 Point Pleasant Drive from 8 a.m. - 4 p.m., Mon. - Fri.

No events will be booked on the following dates:

November 11th, Remembrance day - The annual Remembrance Day ceremony will be held at the Sailor's Memorial.

December 24th - January 2nd inclusive. Christmas Holidays.
